The Minister was very grateful for your kind invitation but unfortunately as indicated to your Assistant, Sylvia last week, the Scottish Parliament is in recess at present and therefore the Minster was unable to attend the photo-call today and regrets she will be unable to attend a viewing at any point later this week.

There was also recently a discussion about the possibility of a site meeting with the Minister to discuss the Trusts proposals for a home for the Prestonpans Tapestry that will also encompass a commemoration of the battle and appropriate interpretation. Whilst the Minister was keen to meet regrettably with the dissolution of the Scottish Parliament on 22 March for the Election in May it will not be possible for her to attend the upcoming Trustees meeting nor now to arrange an alternative date prior to dissolution where she could meet with the Trustees.
